<b>Areas of application</b>	<p><b>Barrique SAN 2</b> is a mild acid, highly active cleanser with antibacterial property, to be used in wine industry for the sanitation of wooden Barrique Barrels.</p> <p><b>Barrique SAN 2</b> should be used in combination with <b>Barrique REI 1</b> as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Step:</b> Mild removal of tartar residues with <b>Barrique REI 1</b></li> <li><b>2. Step:</b> Mild sanitation of the Barrique Barrels with <b>Barrique SAN 2</b></li> </ol> <p>Because of its mild character this cleaning system saves the barrels for a longer use.</p> <p>A special indicator system is included in <b>Barrique SAN 2</b>. The colour of the solutions shows, if the solution is still active or used up.</p> <p><b>violet= active</b>  <b>colourless, yellow, green = used up</b></p>
<b>Method of application</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Step:</b> Depending on the degree of contamination use 2 – 10% of <b>Barrique REI 1</b> in lukewarm water for 15 – 20 min. Then the barrel should be sprayed out thoroughly with water.</li> <li><b>2. Step:</b> Use 0.5 – 2% <b>Barrique SAN 2</b> in lukewarm water, again for 15 – 20 minutes till the solution is becoming violet.</li> <li><b>3. Step:</b> Rinse thoroughly with a plenty of water and fill the barrel with a solution of sulphurous acid.</li> </ol>
<b>Material compatibility</b>	<p>PVDF, PP, PE, PVC, Stainless Steel, Glass and Wood.</p> <p><b>Barrique SAN 2</b> must not be used on Aluminium, Steel and Cast iron.</p> <p>In addition, further material incompatibilities cannot be excluded. Therefore, test the product on an unimportant spot before its definite use.</p>
