<p><b>TENSOL NS</b></p>	<p><b>Item no.:</b> <b>40 33 08</b></p>
<p><b>Areas of application</b></p>	<p><b>Tensol NS</b> is a high concentrated additive for alkaline bath in bottle washing machines and alkaline washing processes.</p> <p><b>Tensol NS</b> is based on special agents to absorb the water hardness and to stabilize the alkalic bath. Special detergents are responsible for better wetting of the bottles and reduce the foam formation in the lye.</p> <p><b>Tensol NS</b> does not include any phosphates and is suitable for phosphate free bottle cleaning.</p> <p><b>Tensol NS</b> activates and increases the cleansing efficiency of the alkaline cleaning solution.</p> <p><b>Tensol NS</b> is suitable for PET-bottles.</p>
<p><b>Method of application</b></p>	<p><b>Add the product with an automatic dosing system (time relay, volumetric control) into the alkaline bathes of the bottle washing machine:</b></p> <p><b>1. First preparation for bathes:</b>                  Concentration: 0.1 – 0.5 % (depending on the hardness of water)                  Temperature: 60 – 90°C                  Time: 15 – 30 minutes</p> <p><b>Subsequent addition:</b>                  Subsequent dosing follows in the relation to the NaOH addition. Use the relation according to the first preparation.</p> <p>After having used the product rinse thoroughly with drinking water to remove any possible residues!</p>
<p><b>Material compatibility</b></p>	<p>PVDF, PP, PE, PVC, Stainless Steel, Glass</p> <p><b>Tensol NS</b> must not be used on aluminium, Steel and Cast Iron. In addition, further material incompatibilities cannot be excluded. Therefore, test the product on an unimportant spot before its definite use.</p>
