#### Rinsing:

It is necessary to use for the rinsing process hot water of drinking water quality, because the product contains quaternary ammonium compounds (QAV). These compounds are difficult to rinse-off. In the technical application it is questionable if it is possible to rinse-off all residues up to a zero value!!
